New National Restrictions from the 5th November

The new National Restrictions mean you must not leave or be outside of your home except for specific purposes. These include:

- for childcare or education, where this is not provided online
- for work purposes, where your place of work remains open and where you cannot work from home (including if your job involves working in other people's homes)
- to exercise outdoors or visit an outdoor public place with the people you live with, with your support bubble or, when on your own, with 1 person from another household (children under school age, as well as those dependent on round-the-clock care, such as those with severe disabilities, who are with their parents will not count towards the limit on two people meeting outside).
- for any medical concerns, reasons, appointments and emergencies, or to avoid or escape risk of injury or harm - such as domestic abuse
- shopping for basic necessities, for example food and medicine, which should be as infrequent as possible
- to visit members of your support bubble or provide care for vulnerable people, or as a volunteer

We ask that all our families follow these guidelines to ensure we stop the spread of Covid in our community and help keep all our bubbles open.

Good attendance in school is essential for children to make up lost learning from the Summer Term.

Please remember that if your child is off school selfisolating this is an authorised absence and if they are not unwell they are entitled to and will be given home learning through Google Classroom.

Please help your child by supporting this home learning and submit their work for feedback from their class teachers.

How to apply for a school place

Children born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017 are due to start primary school in September 2021.

To apply for a school place you must apply online by 15 January 2021 at www.calderdale.gov.uk/admissions.

If you would like a leaflet about applying for a primary school place please contact your preferred school and register your child's name. The leaflet will then be distributed by the primary school at the end of November 2020.

Information relating to Admission to Primary School 2021, including oversubscription criteria, is available at www.calderdale.gov.uk/admissions.

The application process opens on 19 November 2020 and the close date is 15 January 2021

Offers of school places will be made on 16 April 2021.
