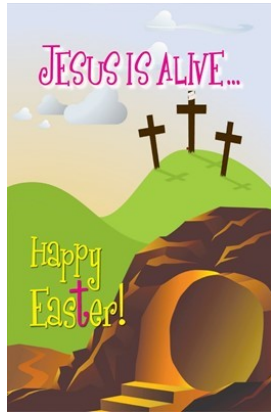
Wednesday 31st March 2021
