Welcome back into our final half term of the year. We are hoping that this term will be action packed with lots of trips and activities.

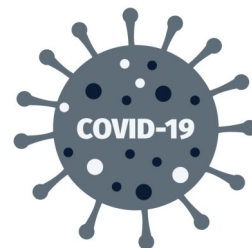

COVID UPDATE

As I am sure you have heard through social media and the news, Todmorden has had a sharp increase in people with Covid-19 and these cases are mainly Delta variant. We have had notification from parents of a few children who are having to self isolate due to being in contact with a positive case.



I would like to reassure parents that these cases are **NOT** linked to school transmission but through children and families socialising outside of school.

The staffing team in school are still taking the Covid restrictions and guidelines seriously and working hard to reduce mixing between our extended bubbles.

We would politely like to remind parents that restrictions and guidelines need to be taken seriously and would encourage everyone to take part in Todmorden's wider testing programme over the next couple of weeks.

On top of this, if you or your child have any Covid-19 symptoms we ask that you get a PCR test and that the whole family isolates until you have the result.

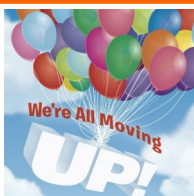

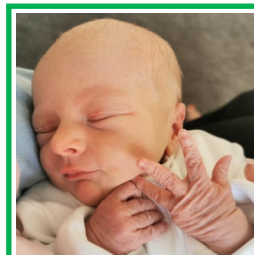
