Dear Families,

I would like to start this letter by thanking all our families for their support during a difficult year. We are so grateful that our parents have supported the Covid measures we have had to put in place in terms of timetabling but also collection and drop off expectations. Your ongoing support of our school is incredibly important to us.

The government has published new operational guidance for schools from Step 4 of the Covid roadmap and these set out the expectations for schools in terms of bubbles and isolations.

The guidance allows schools to remove bubbles when the Government move onto Step 4 of the roadmap and this will be any time after the 19th July. The Government have also recognised that it would be wise to keep bubbles till the end of term. Calderdale LA are also supporting schools to keep bubbles until the end of term due the high cases in our area. It is our intention to remain in bubbles until our closure on the 23rd, this will ensure we remain safe until the holidays allowing staff and children to be able to enjoy their holidays and potential time away.

The bubbles will then be removed in September and children will be able to mix more widely after the Summer holiday.

Also the guidance around isolations have been updated from the beginning of Step 4 (possibly 19th July). If school is informed of one pupil with a positive case, we are now no longer required to send the whole bubble home to self-isolate. Single Case Letters will no longer be sent out to parents. However, if more than one child or adult in the class tests positive, we would seek Public Health advice and all close contacts would likely be sent home.

We have been advised that the Department of Education will update this guidance before 4th September. Should that updated guidance alter any of the above, we will let you know before the children's return to school on Tuesday 7th September.

We will write again before the children return about collection and drop off expectations for September.
