We would like to introduce to parents Anna, who is our new Family Support Worker, she has been employed by school to support our families with issues in the home and out of school.

Anna can support with things such as;

- Support families with issues in the home
- Sign-post children and parents to external services
- Work with external services to support families
- Support parents who are victims of Domestic Abuse
- Refer families to social services or the Early Help Pathway
- Contact parents to discuss home concerns raised in school by children
- Talk to children about their home lives
- Phone families who haven't reported absences to school as part of first day calling
- Deal with medical care plans and sharing of medical information.
